We have begun a new format for Wednesday nights to include a meal and a time of praise and worship to make for an awesome weeknight experience for students. We have new volunteers that are making time to be present and serve students in a new way. (You see how I keep using "new" there huh?)

What is awesome about our new space is that it is actually repurposed or transformed into something new. It reminds me of Romans 12:1-2 MSG 1-2 So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary lifeyour sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around lifeand place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.

When we fix our attention on God, we will be "changed from the inside out." God will do the transforming, but we must be willing to offer our "everyday lives, our sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking around life" to Him for that to happen. We must be willing to create the space, allow Him to renovate our rooms, let go of the things that might keep us in the past. May God continue His renovation of our hearts and lives, and may we celebrate that process with each other as we serve, love, and share together.
