#### A Message from Dennis Johns

The theme of the past month of Wednesday Student J.A.M. studies has been "WAITLISTED." We've been looking at the reality of the fact that God has a plan, but we might have to wait for it. I find it so intriguing how certain things get placed in certain ways while certain things are going on in our lives. Have you ever noticed how God intersects His provision and instruction into our paths through study, a sermon, a relationship or an experience? He gently guides us and nudges us to uncover His love each day.

What I am speaking of is that bit of "aha" that comes from a sermon note when it crosses the path of a personal experience that leads us to worship or that thought from a verse of scripture that you haven't fully put together before. For instance, this Sunday during the "I Am" series, Bro. Robert mentioned Psalm 22:1 "My God...why have you abandoned me" that was quoted by Jesus from the cross. This passage comes immediately before the 23rd Psalm, which speaks of the Divine Shepherd and His overwhelming delivery and protection. This passage is not new to me; but putting the thoughts together in a new reference speaks volumes to the fact that we are never alone or "Waitlisted."

I believe these "aha's" are uncovered as an invitation to worship Him for who He is and what He has done. Psalm 23:3b "He leads me in right paths for His name's sake." He desires to lead us to those moments of discovery for His glory; and just like the parent who experiences their child's first words or first steps, I know that God is delighted when we recognize Him. I also believe that we can increase these "aha's" by putting ourselves in situations that give space for God's presence. When is the last time that you "aha'd" a sunset? Wait, maybe that's an "ahh." Well, I think you get my drift. "Seek first the Kingdom of God."If you're waiting on God, don't give up. Continue to seek Him in every sermon, in every experience, in every relationship, oh, and especially in every sunset.
