First Steps

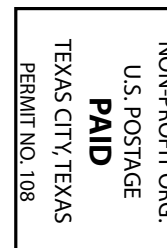

Meet one of our ministers at the First Steps Room after the service to discuss your spiritual decision.



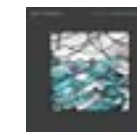

Who's Your One?

Growing up in church, I always looked forward to the Fall and Spring Revivals. I am old enough to remember two-week revivals. Usually, we also had a Youth Revival in the summer. The music was a faster beat. The guest evangelists were always powerful. The small churches I grew up in always had folks saved.

When I began serving churches over forty years ago, that was our model. We would have guest musicians and evangelists a couple of times a year and usually work in a Youth Revival sometime during the year. We had folks saved; and between revivals, we would encourage the new believers to get in Sunday School and some type of discipleship program. I have to confess that I miss those days.

First Baptist Texas City is still remembered for the Starlight Crusades held in the football stadium in the '70s and '80s. The problem is that lost folks quit coming to revivals. Some blame the abuses of tv evangelists; others, that we were too manipulative in our approach. There is probably some truth in both. The only revivals I have known of the past twenty years have been geared more for saved folks than lost people.

Just because our best method for evangelism is no longer effective doesn't mean we are not to do evangelism. That is why we are going to have an evangelism emphasis for the rest of August. We are asking that every member of First Baptist Church identify a lost person. Pray for them. Engage with them. Then invite them to Christ or at least invite them to church. If you read the New Testament, this is the method that the early church used; and it was the most effective in church history. I can't wait to see the results of God's people witnessing for Jesus Christ!
