#### Three Mistaken Views about Divine Healing:

Error 1: I can buy my healing by\_\_\_\_\_.

(Acts 8:9-12, 18-22, Matt. 7:22)

Error 2: It's \_\_\_\_\_ God's will for me to be sick.

(1 Peter 4:19, John 16:33, Phil. 1:29, Col. 1:24, 1 Thess. 3:3)

Error 3: \_\_\_\_\_ ended with the completion of the Bible.

(Hebrews 13:8)

1. When should I pray for \_\_\_\_\_?

(Hurting, Sick, Tired, or Empty)

2. Why aren't people healed \_\_\_\_\_?

\*We don't know God's will.

\*God uses illnesses in many ways.

1) To get my attention and redirect me. (Ps. 119:71, Proverbs 20:30)

2) To be a testimony for others. (Phil. 1:12, John 11:4)

3) To take us into eternity. (Hebrews 9:27, 1 John 5:14)

3. \_\_\_\_\_ can pray for healing? Any Child of God.

(James 5:16-17, Jn. 14:12-13)

4. \_\_\_\_\_ do I pray for healing for myself and others?

1) Make sure my heart is clean. (James 5:16a)

2) Be specific when I ask. (James 4:2b)

3) Ask in faith. (James 1:6)

## First Steps

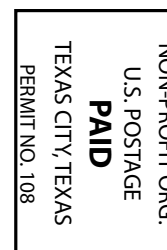
