A Message from Dennis Johns

WHY ARE YOU A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST?

Earlier this month through the Apprentice Institute study that I am involved in, I was asked to articulate the answer to the question: "Why are you a follower of Christ?" It seems such an easy question to answer until you really try and answer it. I began by thinking of what led me to follow Christ in the first place. Initially following Christ was modeled to me by my parents and family. I had a great understanding of Christian values and principals of what it meant to be a follower and participated in practices (going to church, giving, serving) that were consistent with "being a Christian." We were actively involved in the community of local churches that facilitated and encouraged fellowship and spiritual growth. As I grew to understand more through my personal experiences and life in general, I became more aware of His grace and forgiveness and what those things actually meant and felt like. His love has continually compelled me to be a follower. I have not always been the "ideal" follower, but I am a follower of Jesus because I see His ways to contain the real answers to healing brokenness and providing the best possible scenario for life in the future as well as life as I am now living - Life in the Kingdom. I also feel that the best possible place for growth in the "following" is to be a part of the local church - not just here and there but to join in as family. It is a great question to contemplate: Why are you a follower of Christ? I would love to hear your answer and We would love to see you Sunday!

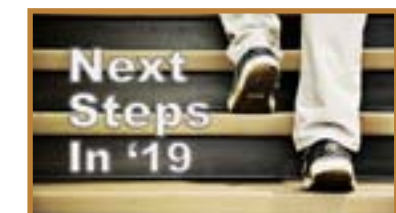

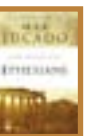
