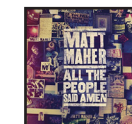

We have a schedule of items that will go into children's shoeboxes for delivery. These items will be assembled into boxes as well as FBCTC members filling boxes on their own, as well as asking other local churches and organizations to participate in helping us get as many boxes as possible for delivery to VBMEC.

Our goal is 500 boxes.

Schedule is as follows:

August - School Supplies - Pencils (w/sharpener) pens, markers, coloring books, crayons, water colors, etc.

September - Wearables/Toys - Socks, stocking caps, hats, t-shirts, wash-cloths, Hot Wheels, dolls, small balls, yo-yo's, jump rope, toys, small instruments, slinky, silly putty, Slinky, etc.

October - Toiletry items/Toys - toothbrushes, tooth paste, hair brushes, combs, shampoo, soap, body spray, nail polish, small toys, etc.
