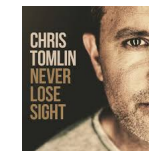

"One generation shall praise Your works to another and shall declare Your mighty acts" (Ps 145:4). It is the duty of every generation of Christ followers to see to it that the next generation hears of the mighty acts of God and responds to those mighty acts in worship.

- This week in VBS a small army of adults and youth have been here declaring God's works to over 100 children! They have given their time and jumped, literally, out of their comfort zone to teach, sing, praise, do motions and even dance in honor of Almighty God!
- Camp Sonshine will be doing the same thing as the theme, Fruit of the Spirit, is taught in song, motions, and actions throughout the day.
- Camps for preteens and youth will continue fulfilling the scripture of praising God's works to the next generation.
- This verse is the driving theme behind Music Camp that will happen June 27-29. One of Jenny Skarke's projects at Baylor was to plan and lead a music camp and she couldn't wait to lead one here. At our camp we'll sing songs, play instruments, learn motions, be taught scripture all while praising God's works to "another generation."

That responsibility is on all of us and specifically applies to fathers this Father's Day. Somewhere along the way, maybe when the book came out, *Real Men Don't Eat Quiche*, we became influenced into thinking that it's not masculine to sing. And to this day, many don't. To that I respond with hearing a stadium full of men singing during an international soccer match, or a Promise Keeper's Rally (several years back), or a men's choir (think Russian men's choir in *The Hunt for Red October*), a men's gospel quartet, etc. I would argue that there's nothing more manly!

Theologian and evangelist John Wesley said this about singing, "Above all sing spiritually. Have an eye to God in every word you sing. Aim at pleasing Him more than yourself, or any other creature..."

Topping all those examples is scripture! The Psalms are plastered with telling ALL of us to sing... "Sing to Him, sing praise to Him; tell of His wonderful acts." Psalm 132:9
