Building Update

The move over to the mall has been exciting. The spirit and enthusiasm over our change have been encouraging to me. Even with so many things still under construction, where we are meeting, everyone has been able to visualize the possibilities of our new building.

The process of getting over here has been complicated. It seems that everything that could go wrong has gone wrong! We had two different contracts on the Mainland property fall through. Even though we have a contract on the front 9 acres and another one on the back 22 acres, we again have run into difficulties on closing. The good news is that both parties still want our property, and we hope to close on both in the next few months. This causes a couple of issues. One, our construction will need to stop until we receive money from the sale. Two, we ordered an air conditioner chiller for our new building (thinking we were going to close in July) that needs to have a payment of \$200,000 made in the next few weeks. God will provide!

With everything that has gone wrong, it would be easy to start second guessing and get discouraged, but I am choosing to face these adversities with faith. First, it has become apparent to me Satan did not want us in this building and has fought to keep this from happening. Second, since moving to the Mall, we are having more guests than we have ever had in the ten years I have been the pastor. Third, God has always affirmed in my Spirit that we have made the right choice. God is in this, and He will see us through. To God be the Glory!
